GUIDELINES FOR PRE-INDICTMENT PROGRAM (PIP)

- I. The following offenses are eligible for PIP (see starting dates):

- II. The following requirements apply to PIP:
1. Defendant can have no prior adult felony conviction or pending or discharged adult deferred adjudication.
 2. Defendant must dispose of all other Collin County cases prior to plea in PIP case(s).
 3. Defendant must pay full restitution (excluding drug testing fee) prior to plea in PIP case(s).
- III. The following non-negotiable plea bargain offers (including all standard or required conditions of community supervision) will apply in PIP:

- IV. **The length of community supervision and fine amount will be increased in post-indictment plea bargain offers. PIP defendants who refuse to plea prior to indictment should not expect a later offer of deferred adjudication.**
